

Notice of Public Hearing
Columbia Regional Airport
Airside, Landside, and Surface Transportation Developments
Columbia, Missouri

The City of Columbia intends to undertake the following proposed actions at the Columbia Regional Airport:

- Rehabilitate or reconstruct airfield pavement
- Realign South Rangeline Road
- Acquire 52 acres of land
- Realign Route H
- Improve Runway 13 and parallel Taxiway B
- Construct Taxiway A5 and infield drainage improvements
- Widen Taxiway A4
- Rehabilitate South Apron Area
- Expand apron between Taxiways A2 and A3
- Improve Runway 20 and parallel Taxiway A
- Expand auto parking lot

Pursuant to the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Order 1050.1E, Change 1, a Draft Environmental Assessment has been prepared for these proposed actions. The results of the Draft EA indicate that there would not be any significant adverse impacts associated with the proposed actions. At the request of a member of the public, the City is holding a Public Hearing to provide the public with an opportunity to discuss the project and ask questions about the impacts the project may have on the environment.
