

Notice of Availability for Final Environmental Assessment for Proposed Actions at Columbia Regional Airport Columbia, Missouri

This is a newspaper notice of availability for the Final Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Proposed Action at Columbia Regional Airport in Columbia, Missouri. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has signed the Final EA and issued a FONSI approving the Proposed Action which involves the following project components:

- Rehabilitate or reconstruct airfield pavement
- Realign South Rangeline Road
- Acquire 52 acres of land
- Realign Route H
- Improve Runway 13 and parallel Taxiway B
- Construct Taxiway A5 and infield drainage improvements
- Widen Taxiway A4
- Rehabilitate South Apron Area
- Expand apron between Taxiways A2 and A3
- Improve Runway 20 and parallel Taxiway A
- Expand auto parking lot

This notice of availability has been published in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended (NEPA) (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.), Council on Environmental Quality NEPA implementing regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and FAA Order 1050.1E, Change 1.
